Dear McLean Patients, Residents and Families,

This morning we became aware of an asymptomatic employee who received a positive test result for the COVID-19 virus during our weekly surveillance testing. This employee is on our care team and works on our Assisted Living neighborhoods.

This employee is isolating at home and we have conducted thorough contact tracing. Anyone who had been in contact with this team member has already been individually notified. As a result, we have implemented appropriate precautionary measures.

Per the Department of Public Health, all inside and outside visits have been suspended for both Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing neighborhoods. A member of our Life Enrichments team will be contacting all families who have visits already scheduled to offer a virtual visit. All compassionate care and end-of-life visits are able to continue.

Per the recommendation of epidemiology, all neighborhoods in our Health Center are closed and our courtyard is also closed. Small group activities, including dining, will be discontinued at this time. The Hairdresser and Barber Shop are also closed.

These measures will be in effect until we have two full weeks of 100% negative COVID-19 test results for all staff and Assisted Living residents.

We will continue with our weekly surveillance testing strategy and will report any positive results to you.
