Dear McLean Patients, Residents and Families,

We are sending an update today to let you know of four residents who tested positive for COVID-19 as a result of our surveillance testing. One resident resides on The Atwater and three reside on The Robinson. All are isolating in their residences. We also have one employee who tested positive and is isolating at home.

Contact tracing is currently underway; anyone who has been potentially exposed will be contacted individually by our care team. Precautionary measures continue to be implemented to prevent the spread of the virus.

This does, unfortunately, mean we need to suspend small group activities, including dining as well as inside visits, except for compassionate care and end of life visits, until we have two full weeks of 100% negative COVID-19 test results. We will continue surveillance testing of all assisted living and skilled nursing residents and staff and our mitigating strategies until we have two full weeks of 100% negative COVID-19 test results.
