Contact tracing is complete and they did not have any contact with residents or staff since they have not been working on campus. They are currently isolating at home.

We would like to share with you that this individual has been fully vaccinated which brings up some important reminders to us all. Whether a person is vaccinated or not, face masks must be worn at all times, social distancing must continue unless all parties are vaccinated, and recommended cleaning processes continued.

Due to the nature of this individual's non-contact with any residents or employees, we will not need to change any of the mitigating strategies at this time. All small group activities, including small group dining, and inside visitation, will continue.
