Dear McLean Patients, Residents, and Families,

We are writing to keep you informed on our current COVID-19 status. We have two new COVID-19 positive employees. One person is from our nursing staff who works on the Evergreen Way and Chapel Crossing neighborhoods, and the second person has not worked in our building since December. Contact tracing is still occurring and anyone who had a potential exposure will be notified. Both are currently isolating at home.

All the health center residents – both skilled nursing and assisted living – were tested again on Thursday per protocol. Some tests are still pending, but so far, the results have been negative.

Based on the Department of Public Health’s guidance, we will continue our staff testing to occur every five to seven days and our resident testing will occur once a week at this time.

We continue to welcome visitation, but please remember there is a risk of entering the building when we have an outbreak. If you believe you are at higher risk, i.e., you or someone you are caring for is not vaccinated and/or has underlying health issues, please consider not visiting at this time. We would be happy to arrange a virtual visit instead.

Due to high transmission rates in our county, please consider testing before visiting. If you have had direct exposure to a newly COVID-19 positive person, please test before you visit. If you test positive, do not visit. If you, or anyone that visits McLean, should test positive within 14 days of visiting us, please call the nursing supervisor right away.

As a reminder, at the Well Screen machine, please click that you are a “visitor for patient/resident.” Please do not click on “contractor/entertainer/vendor.” This helps with contact tracing. A mask needs to be worn into the building and a KN95 mask must be worn at all times while in the building (provided near the Well Screen machine). Social distancing is required at all times.
