Dear McLean Health Center Families, Employees, and Residents,

Per a continued CMS requirement, we are writing to keep you informed on our current COVID-19 status. We have two residents who live on the Skyview Terrace neighborhood, one resident who lives on Chapel Crossing, and one employee who works on the Chapel Crossing neighborhood who have tested positive. Contact tracing is underway and anyone with a potential exposure will be notified. Testing for residents and employees on these neighborhoods will continue per current protocol.

You are welcome to join your loved one for a meal as long as you are in the resident's private room; private assisted living apartment; or private, designated meeting area. We are no longer using SimplyBook.me. If you are interested in scheduling a private room, please email... bookings@mcleancare.org and a form will be emailed back for you to complete your request. - Please perform a COVID-19 test if you have a runny nose or any cold symptoms prior to visiting.
- We strongly encourage visitors to wear a surgical mask while in the building.
- Prior to entering the room of a COVID-19 positive or symptomatic resident, please check with a nurse regarding additional personal protective equipment needed.
- If you, or anyone that visits McLean, discover you are COVID-19 positive within ten days of visiting us, please call the nursing supervisor right away so we can take the appropriate actions immediately to assess the potential exposure to stop potential spread.
