Per a continued CMS requirement, we are writing to keep you informed on our current COVID-19 status. We have two employees who have tested positive. One works in dining and one works in the health center. Contact tracing has been completed and anyone with a potential exposure has been notified.

- Please do not visit if you are not feeling well.
- Prior to visiting, please perform a COVID-19 test if you have a runny nose or any cold symptoms.
- We strongly encourage visitors to wear a surgical mask while in the building.
- Prior to entering the room of a COVID-19 positive or symptomatic resident, please check with a nurse regarding additional personal protective equipment needed.
- If you, or anyone that visits McLean, discover you are COVID-19 positive within ten days of visiting us, please call the nursing supervisor right away so we can take the appropriate actions immediately to assess the potential exposure to stop potential spread.
