Game Refuge

Much like 2023, this year was heavily influenced by unusual weather. El Niño rains saturated the spring forests of the Game Refuge. Then a weakened La Niña brought warm dry weather through December. Projects delayed in the spring were completed in rapid succession in the fall, including improvements to the gravel surfaces of Brook Road, Broad Hill Road, and Pond Road. We also improved access from the main parking areas to trail heads and resurfaced Chestnut Road from Route 10 to Trout Pond in our efforts to make the Game Refuge more accessible to visitors traveling in strollers and wheelchairs.


Each year we add numerous new species to our comprehensive registry of living things at the Game Refuge, what we call our All-Taxa Database. A flurry of new flying creatures highlighted the finds of 2024 including three state-listed birds – Bobolink, Common Loon, and Red-Headed Woodpecker – and four state-listed bats – Hoary Bat, Tri-Colored Bat, Silver-Haired Bat, and Eastern Red Bat. These species of special concern together with a bevy of insects, plants, fungi, and other critters accounted for over 60 new additions to our database.


Game Refuge staff worked closely this year with a wonderful collection of researchers, conservation partners, and community members to care for our forest, wildlife, and historical heritage. Our seventh season of Forest Crew members worked with research partners to treat hemlock trees, monitor forest habitat, use acoustic monitors for bats, and excavate Native American sites older than the pyramids of Egypt. Our Development and Marketing teams met with neighbors to gain perspective and strengthen community ties. Most importantly, our Director, President, and Board clarified our mission and refined our strategy for the coming years.


With generous, continuing support from the Richard P. Garmany Fund, we are able to provide two important programs for the benefit of our community.

The "McLean Presents" performance series, offered free of charge thanks to the Richard P. Garmany Fund, is very well-known in our community. We have presented 19 performances, with attendance of over 2,700 people. Guests at each performance are divided equally between the public and residents of McLean, including those from our Skilled Nursing, Assisted Living, and Independent Living neighborhoods. Featured performers include local talents, non-profit arts groups, and artists from beyond Connecticut.

The Forest Ranger program is a paid professional training internship designed for college undergraduates to develop conservation and land management skills while working for a summer at the McLean Game Refuge. This program is a wonderful success that has supported the Game Refuge tremendously through the hard work, bright ideas, and enthusiasm of college students. It has increased the capacity of the Game Refuge to engage in habitat management, trail maintenance, and connection with the community. Forest Ranger alumni have taken their skills acquired at the Game Refuge to dozens of organizations locally, regionally, and nationally.

Hospice Care

This program has a long history of serving the Farmington Valley with clinical excellence and compassion for patients as well as their loved ones. One client had been an avid life-long swimmer, who, due to their illness, could no longer swim. Our home health aides and nurses worked together to develop a plan and safely enabled the client to swim at their independent living facility, making it a weekly tradition that brought joy to both the client and their family.

We are most proud of our truly extraordinary volunteer program. Over the past year, our volunteers provided 600 hours of their time that included pet therapy, music therapy, reiki, and life review. We are fortunate to have committed staff and volunteers who bring "life to the days" of our clients. In the past year, hospice has served 427 patients within our community and on the McLean campus. We also welcomed a new hospice director to guide the team.


