

Phone scams seem to be increasing in frequency. Technology continues to make it easier for scammers to find out basic information about you and your family. They can even disguise their voices as someone you know. These scammers are VERY convincing!

#### Never give out:

- · Credit card information
- · Bank information
- · Social Security numbers
- · Any personal information

If it sounds too good to be true, it usually is! One suggestion is to have a "key" word or phrase that you share only with your family to use as identification. That way, if you get a call from someone claiming to be a family member, you have a "test" to know if it's a scam.
